  - Certificate of Registration of Society/Trust/Company
  - Self Drinking Water and Sanitary Condition Certificate
- The School shall also ensure the compliances with the Board's Bye-laws in regard of following facilities and infrastructures within 3 months and submit compliance as SARAS portal.
  - Boundary Wall: Concrete boundary wall of not less than 6 ft. height, enclosing the school campus/site. Composite boundary walls which are partly concrete and partly grid/brick/charted wire fence 6 feet will not be acceptable. If fencing/gate is required, then the same should be even and above 6 feet height.
  - Ramps at the entrance(s) as well as Ramp(s) for CWSS, to access the upper floors of the school (in case of a multi-storied school) (Circular No. CBEA/AF-05/2023 dated 06.03.2023).
  - Separate toilet for CWSS, boys and girls on every floor (in case of multi-storied schools) (Circular No. CBEA/AF-05/2023 dated 06.03.2023).
  - Appropriate laboratory infrastructure for Secondary School (Composite Science Lab, Mathematics Lab, Computer Lab) and for Senior Secondary School (Composite Science Lab, Mathematics Lab, Computer Lab, Physics Lab, Chemistry Lab, Biology Lab) (Circular no. CBEA/AF-11/2023 dated 04.10.2023).
  - Well-ventilated library with adequate reading area. (Circular no. CBEA/AF-11/2022 dated 04.10.2022)
  - Well-developed indoor and outdoor sports facilities. (Circular no. CBEA/AF-11/2022 dated 04.10.2022)
  - Well-developed Digital Infrastructure (Circular No. CBEA/AF-09/2023 dated 24.03.2023)

Failure to comply within the prescribed time may invite financial penalty @ 30,000/- per month until compliance is submitted and may defer the school from filling the registration and LOC of students' class IX to class XII, as the case may be.

If the compliance is not submitted within the stipulated 3 months, the Board may release the penalty amount and defer the schools from filling up registration/LOC details of students of classes IX to XII, as the case may be, in the term academic session i.e. 2024-25.
